Forklift Seats - A seat is a strong, strong surface to be seated, usually raised above floor level. Normally used by one person, nearly all seats are on the support of four legs, although some may be in a triangular shape using just three legs. A stool is a kind of seat which does not have any arm rests or a back rest. A seat that has folding action and an inclining footrest is called a recliner, whereas a seat together with arms only is considered an arm seat. If a seat has connected wheels, it can be referred to as a wheelseat and if the seat is hung from above, it is referred to as a swing. A permanently attached seat in a train or a theatre is called a seat or airline seat, yet when riding; it is a saddle as in bicycle saddle. A car seat is the type utilized within vehicles and an infant car seat would be a kind of seat specially meant for young kids.

The design of the seat could differ somewhat considerably so as to accommodate several requirements and aesthetic tastes. As an instance, designs can be decorated with drilled openings, can consist of gaps or low backs for ventilation or be made of porous materials. The seat back can be designed as an included headrest by extending the height over the occupant's head. Seats could be made together with an attached, built in footrest or come with a separate matching ottoman. An ottoman is a short stool that is designed to be used as a movable footrest. Every so often the ottoman can be mounted to a glider chair with swing arms, permitting the ottoman to rock back and forth with the glider similar to a rocking chair along with a built-in footrest.

Seat covers are temporary cloth covers utilized for a seat that can offer protection against wear and add attractiveness. A large range of seat covers from neoprene to leather are now obtainable. More formal materials can be rented for occasions such as weddings in order to enhance the decor. Several seat covers have decorative seat ties or ribbons connected to be tied at the rear of the seat in a ribbon or decorative knot. Some individuals utilize custom clear plastic furniture covers to protect their pricey sofas and seats.

Seat pads are cushions designed for seats, often decorative; they could also be used in motor vehicles to be able to increase the drivers' height. Orthopaedic backrests offer support for the back, often in lower spine or lumbar area. A few manufacturers have their seat pad designs patented and are recognized by certain medical organizations.
